We offer a range of blended approaches, from remote engagement to self-directed learning through our CPD platforms, as well as face to face where required. But to help more people access our support and training most of our support will be provided remotely through our digital TEAMS platform. Whether you want to join a structured training programme with a group, to undertake e-learning, or get one to one wellbeing support from our learning mentors, you can do so remotely, providing you with the flexibility and accessibility to fit your learning around your other commitments.

## **Level 1 Courses Overview**

The Level 1 courses are suitable if you have no prior knowledge or experience in health and social care, or have just started out working in the sector and wish to develop your knowledge in specific areas. The courses are based on two days learning a week, enabling you

time between sessions to reflect and develop your understanding from the learning undertaken in each session. They will be delivered in a blended way; remotely online in a 'virtual live classroom' and through e-learning.

The Level 2 courses are suitable for those with a Level 1 in health and social care or a related field. You will have the opportunity to develop your generic knowledge of health and social care work and practice standards, as well as develop and enhance your knowledge in areas of specialism within the sector. The courses

are based on two days learning a week, enabling you time between sessions to reflect and develop your understanding from the learning undertaken in each session. They will be delivered in a blended way; remotely online in a 'virtual live classroom' and through e-learning.

# **Specialist Training**

Specialist training is available in those areas that employers really like to see on CVs. They are considered as critical knowledge when working in care. The Care Certificate is required in all regulatory care settings and it must be completed by all staff as part of their induction to a new roll. Here at the Care Academy we can help you get a head start by introducing you to what the Care Certificate is all about, giving you the confidence to start a role in care, as well as increasing your opportunity to get a job. This will be delivered by a tutor in our remote 'live virtual classrooms'.

The moving and handling of people is essential for anyone wishing to work in a role that involves personal care and physically mobilising people in a care and support environment. Undertaking this course will increase your chances of gaining employment greatly. This is a two day face to face course.

The Trusted Advisor is also sought-after training employers look for care staff to have. This course can help you stand you out from the crowd, as you will be ready to advise, assess or install minor adaptations for people in their homes, making it more suitable or accessible for their needs. This is delivered both remotely and face to face.

# Functional Skills (English, Maths, Digital literacy)

To study level 1 or above qualifications in health and social care or to increase your employment chances, you are required to have at least a level 1 or equivalent in English and Maths. If you do not have this already, the Care Academy can support you to achieve this with our functional skills programme.

You will need to register on our English or Maths skills if you do not have a level 1. You can undertake these courses alongside your health and social care qualifications, or if you prefer you may undertake your functional skills first.

You will also be able to increase your level of English and Maths if you are studying higher level qualifications.

We also offer a digital literacy course which helps you improve your IT skills, to help with studying or in the workplace. As many qualifications and employers require you to use IT more and more, having a digital literacy qualification can also boost your chances of employment, create more opportunities, and access to learning.

## Workskills

This course is an opportunity for you to gain an insight into working in care through work placements. It will help you to gain confidence and skills in searching, applying and interviewing for jobs. The course delivered

remotely. You will start off with learning about what it takes to get a job in care, building up to work experience that enables you to make an informed decision about the jobs you want to apply for.
